When I was applying for my PGCE, I was able to receive individual feedback and guidance on my personal statement by booking one-to-one appointments with a Careers Adviser, who was extremely helpful and supportive. I also had an opportunity to complete a mock interview, which was a valuable experience that greatly increased my confidence.

SEA has helped me figure out my career goals and how I can achieve them to become a primary school teacher.
